The **pre-registration entry fee is \$25** (per angler). Payments must be received by August 25, 2006 to qualify for the pre-registration fee. The **on-site registration fee is \$30** (per angler) and you can register at the three locations referenced below. **All pre-registered anglers must pick up their registration kits at the Mammoth Lakes Registration Area.**

All registrations includes a \$10.00 donation to the Hot Creek Hatchery Foundation, a registration kit with lots of goodies, fishing license holder, and a chance to win \$1,000,000!*. As an incentive to pre-register, the Hot Creek Hatchery Foundation is including a free raffle ticket for their boat & motor in your registration kit. On-site site registration does not include a Hot Creek Hatchery Foundation raffle ticket, but you may purchase one at the Mammoth Lakes registration area, at Troutstock Village, or at the awards ceremony on Monday, September 4, 2006, at the Hot Creek Hatchery Foundation booth.

Official Contest Rules & Regulations

1. Each angler entered into the competition must submit a registration form and payment prior to fishing. No registration will be permitted to an angler who has already caught a tagged trout.
2. There is no minimum age required to participate. However, if you are older than 16 years of age, you must hold your own California fishing license. If you are under 18 years of age, a parent or legal guardian must sign your registration form below and accompany you to the awards ceremony.
3. Participant or parent / legal guardian must have a valid Social Security Number.
4. All registered anglers must abide by 2006 Freshwater Sport Fishing Regulations administered by the California Department of Fish and Game.
 - a. If fishing on Crowley Lake: No bait and no attractants are permitted - only artificial and barbless hooks are allowed. Only 2 fish per day are allowed to be kept and they must be at least 18" long. In the event a tagged fish is caught that is less than 18" long, it must be kept alive while presented to the Check-In Point, then released after its tag is removed by a tournament official.
5. There is no limit as to the number of tagged trout one angler may catch during the competition.
6. **Hours of the competition are:** Sunrise to Sunset on Saturday, September 2; Sunrise to Sunset on Sunday, September 3; Sunrise to 11:00 a.m. on Monday, September 4. Any registered angler caught fishing outside of these hours will be automatically disqualified without refund.
7. Contestant must present the tagged fish to an official Million Dollar Troutstock Check-In point on the same day caught (*See map in registration kit for locations by area*).

Hours of Check-In Points are: Saturday & Sunday, September 2nd & 3rd, 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. Monday, September 4th, 7:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. It will be the decision of the judges if the fish is deemed to have been caught earlier and preserved.

TAGS MAY ONLY BE REMOVED BY A TOURNAMENT OFFICIAL.

8. All participants will exercise good and courteous sportsmanship whether on land, or fishing. Violators will be subject to disqualification without refund.

The Awards Ceremony

9. The awards ceremony will be conducted on Monday, September 4th at Sam's Woods in Mammoth Lakes at 1:00pm. **Contestants must be present to win.** (*See map in registration kit*).
10. 500 Alpers Trout will be tagged and released proportionately in the following eligible lakes: Lake Mary, Lake Mamie, Lake George, Upper & Lower Twin Lakes (Mammoth Lakes Basin), Convict Lake, Crowley Lake, Bridgeport Reservoir, June Lake, Gull Lake, Silver Lake, Grant Lake, Lundy Lake, Saddlebag Lake, Upper & Lower Twin (Bridgeport), Big Virginia Lake, Little Virginia Lake and Trumbull Lake.
11. Any angler catching a tagged fish will have their tag number entered into a random draw.
12. Only the first tag number randomly selected in this event will be eligible for \$1,000,000, only the second tag number randomly selected in this event will be eligible for \$500,000 etc. Beginning with the first tag number randomly selected the Grand Prize will decrease in value as scheduled: 1st Tag Number \$1,000,000, 2nd Tag Number \$500,000, 3rd Tag Number \$100,000, 4th Tag Number \$50,000, 5th Tag Number \$25,000, 6th -10th Tag Numbers \$10,000, 11th-100th Tag Numbers \$5,000, 101st Tag Number wins a prize package.
13. To win, the randomly selected tag number must match the pre-selected number. The amount of the prize is determined by the position in the draw. Example: If the 10th tag randomly selected in this event matches the one pre-selected Grand Prize winning tag number, angler will win \$10,000, if it is the 24th tag number, angler will win \$5,000, etc.
14. In the event the contestant wins a monetary prize, he/she must complete and sign a Winner's Affidavit & Release, and must present a copy of a government issued identification card containing a photo of the claimed winner. Winner, or winner's legal guardian, will also be required to fill out a W-9 form. In addition, if a monetary prize of between \$50,000 and \$1,000,000 is awarded, winner will be required to submit to and pass a polygraph examination.
15. In the event the contestant wins one million dollars (\$1,000,000), the prize will be payable in forty (40) equal annual installments of twenty five thousand (\$25,000) each, without interest.
16. In the event the contestant wins five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000), the prize will be payable in twenty (20) equal annual installments of twenty five thousand (\$25,000) each, without interest.
17. The winner, or winner's legal guardian if under 18 years of age, is responsible for paying any and all taxes on any prize won and must authorize the deduction of such taxes, if any, from the prize to the extent required by law.
18. Names and likenesses of promotion winner(s) may be used by the Event Organizer and Event Organizer's designee(s) for promotional purposes without further compensation to Event Organizer or the promotion winner(s)
19. Employees, agents, successors, and assignees of Sponsor, its advertising agencies and promotional companies involved in this promotion, as well as family and household members of same, shall be ineligible to participate in the promotion and shall be ineligible for any prize covered herein.
