Purchase license at sporting goods and other various stores throughout Mono County. (partial listing on reverse side) 16 years and older must have a valid fishing license, 15 years and under no license required.

Mammoth Creek: Ice free

Twin Lakes: Partially free of ice

Lake Mary: Road still closed, snow & ice

Lake Mamie: Road still closed, snow & ice

Lake George: Road still closed, snow & ice

Reds Meadow Area

Sotcher Lake: Road still closed, snow & ice

Starkweather Lake: Road still closed, snow & ice

Fishing season ends November 15, 2005

June Lake Loop

June Lake: 35%-40% ice free

Gull Lake: Almost completely ice free

Silver Lake: Openings on either end of lake, still lots of ice

Grant Lake: Still frozen, rotting ice

Tioga & Ellery Lakes: Tioga Pass still closed, snow

Lundy Lake: Road partially open, ice/snow on lake

Virginia Lakes: Road still closed, snow & ice

Bridgeport Area

Bridgeport Reservoir: Open & ice free

Twin Lakes Bridgeport:

Upper - Partially open & ice free

Lower - Open & ice free
